Town Council Meeting
March 9, 2011

Minutes:

There wasn't a quorum in attendance so no official business was conducted.

Deputy Peatross reported on the use of Spice in the County, indicating that the State of Utah passed laws against the use of Spice.

The sheriff's department responded to two drug cases in Amalga.

Mayor Wood indicated we were not getting enough traffic tickets written in Amalga and asked the deputy if he could request the sheriff's department to increase the amount of time deputies spend in our community. Deputy Peatross reported that the deputies write 5 or 6 tickets a month in Amalga.
